**Subject: Jute Seed Export Permission (JRO-524-NABIN) to Bangladesh**


This is with regard to the required DAC permission of jute seed export to Bangladesh from India. Every year 5000 MT (Avg) certified jute seed is exported to Bangladesh from February - April and the total amount of Foreign Exchange earned during the total season is \$ 1 crore (U.S. dollar).

We would like to keep you informed that the certified seed of JRO-524-NABIN production assignment in Guntur is taken up by few producers exclusively for the purpose of export to Bangladesh for our member exporters. It has also been informed by our member companies that there was a good quantity of jute seed produced last year is lying at the end of the Exporter companies and producers.

This year our member companies have given proposal for the permission of jute seed export for 6060 MT through NSAI. We humbly request you to consider their proposals and permit them for jute seed export (JRO-524-NABIN) for the applied quantity.
