

## **NSAI GC ELECTION GUIDELINES 2023-2025**

### **Election Schedule (02:30-07:00 PM):**

1. Announcement of the Election Process by Chairman Election Committee
2. Address by Contesting Candidate
3. Voting
4. Announcement of results

### **Nomination Procedure:**

- 1. All the 3 signatories (nominee, proposer, seconder) on any nomination form must be from the same category.**


*For Example:*

- I. In 'Ordinary Category' in order to file the nominations, the nominee from Ordinary Category has to be proposed and seconded by other ordinary members only who are appearing in the electoral list.
- II. In 'Association Category' in order to file the nominations, the nominee from Association Category has to be proposed and seconded by other association members only who are appearing in the electoral list.
- III. In 'Associate Category' in order to file the nominations, the nominee from Associate Category has to be proposed and seconded by other association members only who are appearing in the electoral list.

2. Ordinary Member can propose /second Maximum five (5) candidates.  
Association Member can propose/second Only one (1) candidate.  
Associate Member can propose/second Only one (1) candidate.
3. Even if a candidate is contesting in election in ordinary category, he may propose /second other four candidate's nomination. However, this would be subject to the name of his company appearing in the electoral list in the same category.
4. Nomination Forms can also be downloaded from NSAI website [www.nesai.co.in](http://www.nesai.co.in) , can be duly filled up and sent to NSAI secretariat, addressed to the Chairman Election Committee. The envelope should be marked as '**NOMINATION FOR NSAI GC ELECTION 2023**' otherwise the same would be rejected.

**Other Important Points :**

1. Proxy forms which are bar coded and company/member specific have been sent along with a specific envelope. The members are expected to send the proxy form in original in the specific envelope provided.
2. Nomination and proxy forms should not be sent in the same envelope. In that case both the Nomination and Proxy form would be invalid.
3. NSAI would publish the names of eligible candidates on 29.08.2023 both through email and on NSAI website.
4. In the Nomination form, the Company name/ name of the candidate must be as per the Electoral List of NSAI Election 2023.
5. In event of **loss or non-receipt of proxy form**, members are required to immediately contact NSAI secretariat by mail ([election@nsai.co.in](mailto:election@nsai.co.in)) or on company letterhead with sign & stamp by 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 to issue duplicate proxy form.
6. Under no circumstances, photocopy of proxy forms will be accepted. Also, incomplete applications (proxy and nomination) will be summarily rejected.
7. In case of multiple Proxies are received from the same voter (member company), all the proxies from the same member (company) would be invalid.
8. Any application for proxy form received after the deadline will not be entertained.
